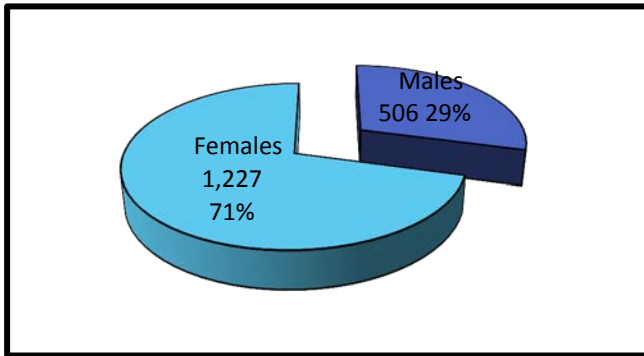

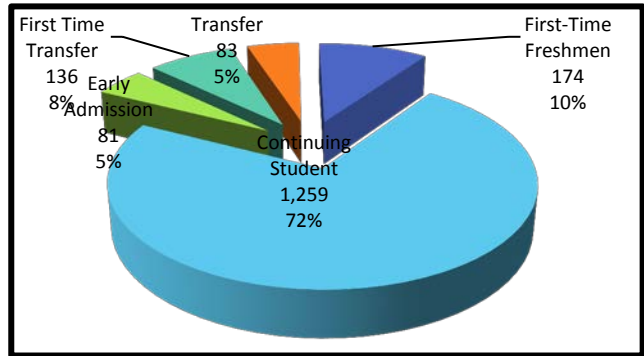

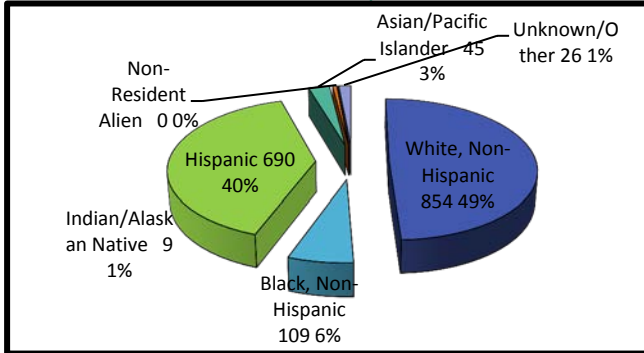
Total Enrollment by Gender



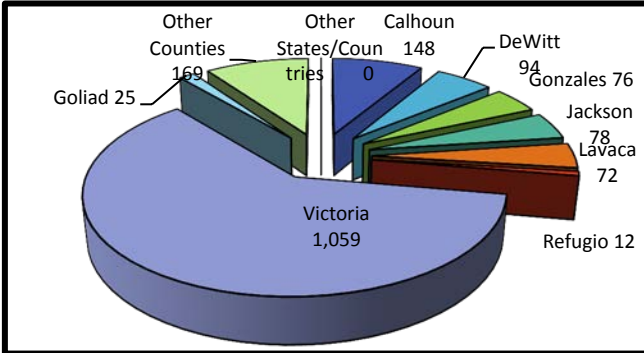
Student Classification



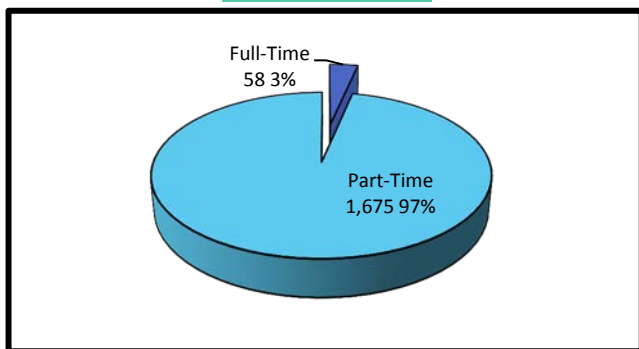
Enrollment by Race



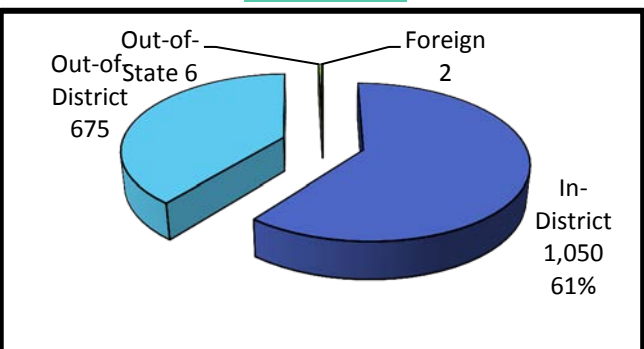
Student Counties of Residence



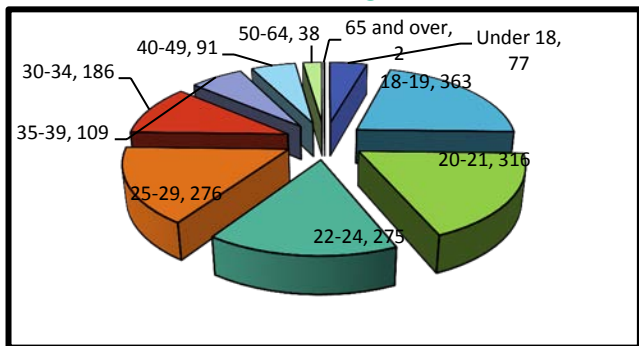
Enrollment Status



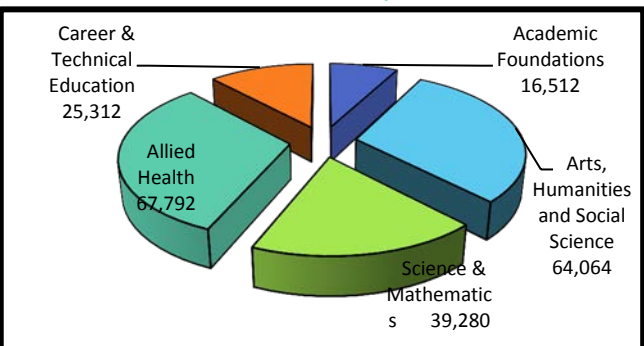
Tuition Status

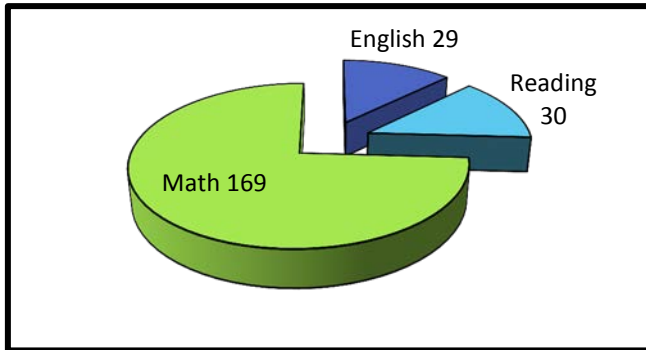

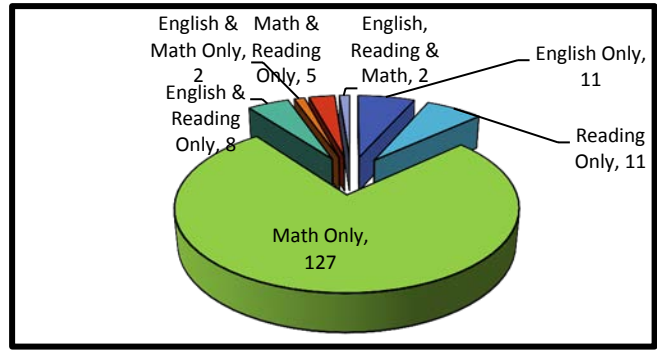

Enrollment by Area

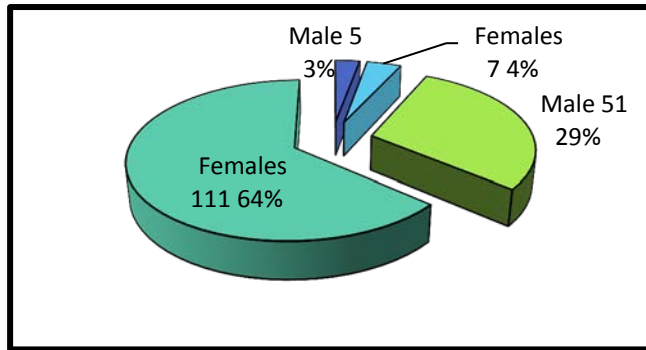


Enrollment by Combination

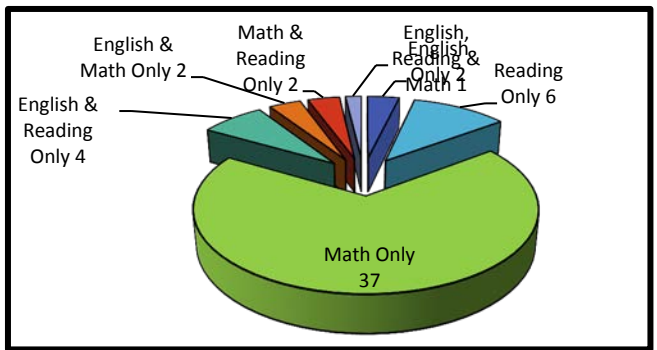


PROFILE: FIRST TIME IN COLLEGE (FTIC)

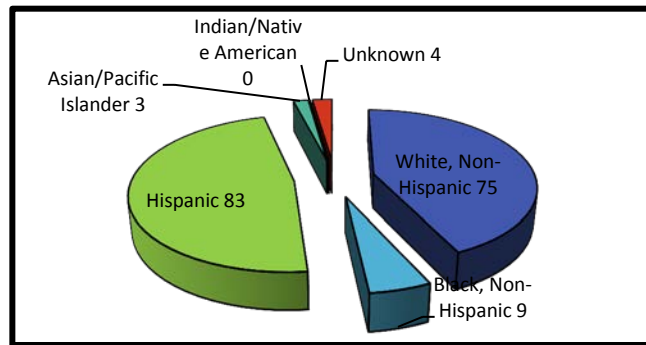
Enrollment Status by Gender



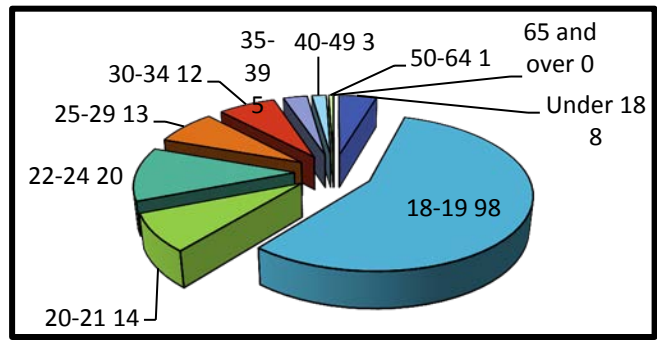
Developmental Education Combined Enrollment



Enrollment by Ethnicity

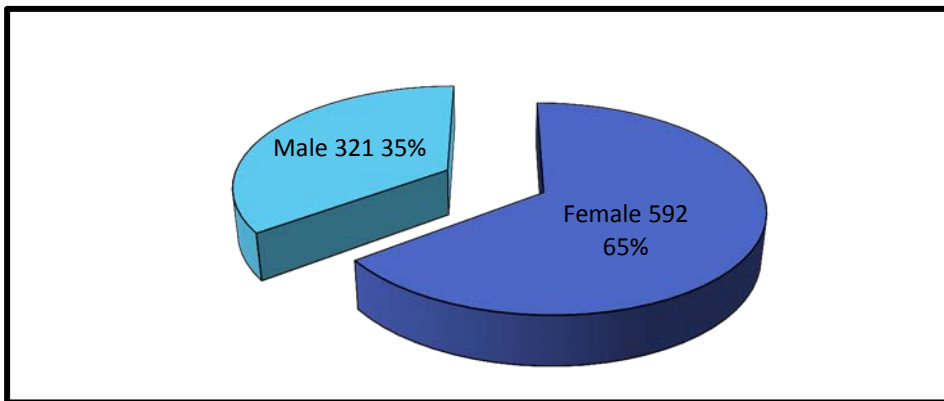


Enrollment by Age

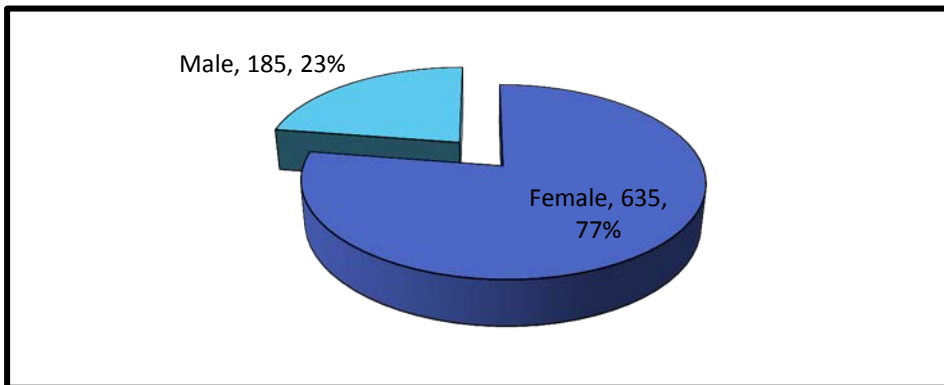


SUMMER STUDENT HEADCOUNT BASED ON DECLARED MAJOR

Student Gender in Academic Majors

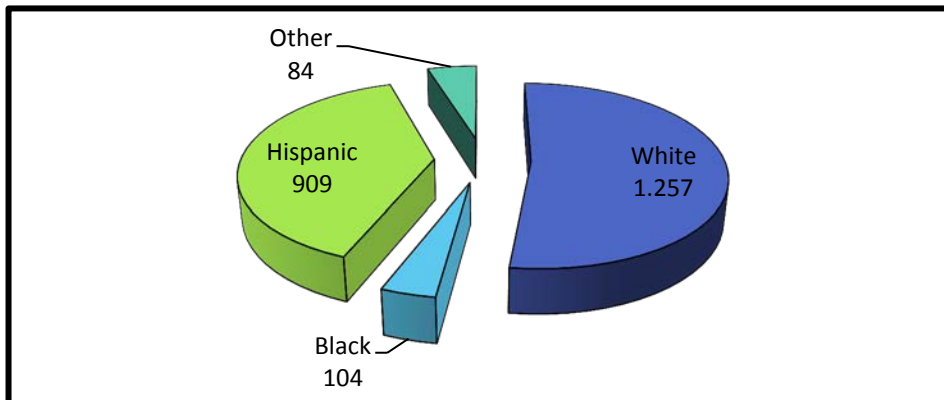


Student Gender in Career and Technical Education Programs

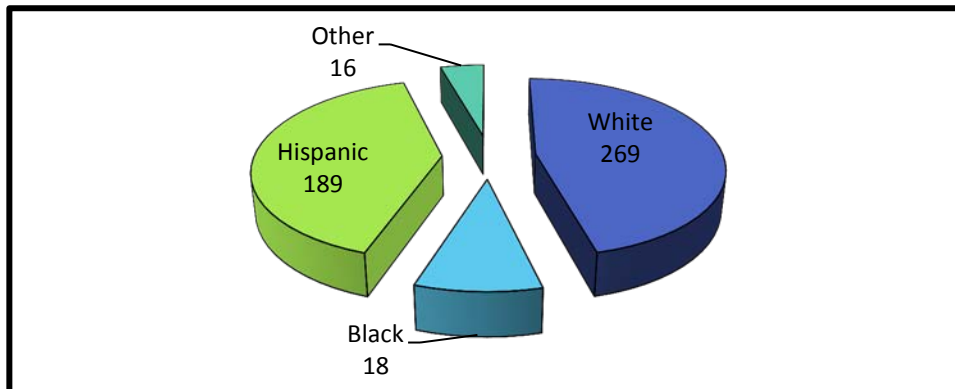

Student Ethnicity in Academic Programs



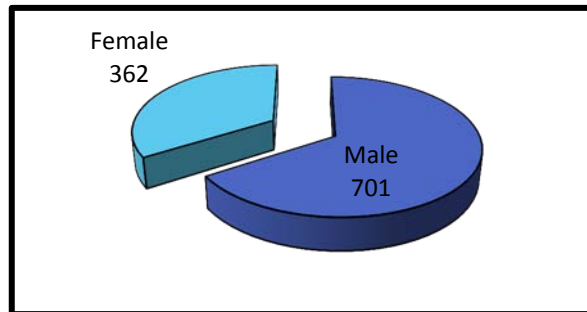
Student Ethnicity in Career Health and Technical Professions



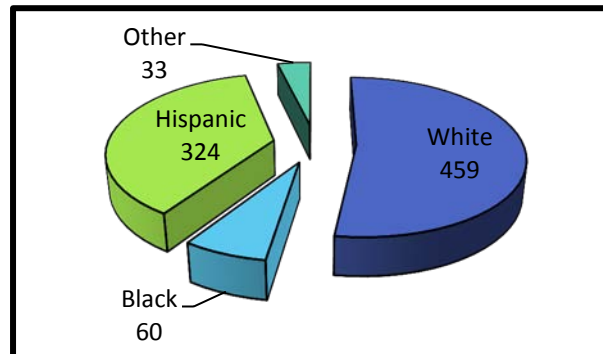

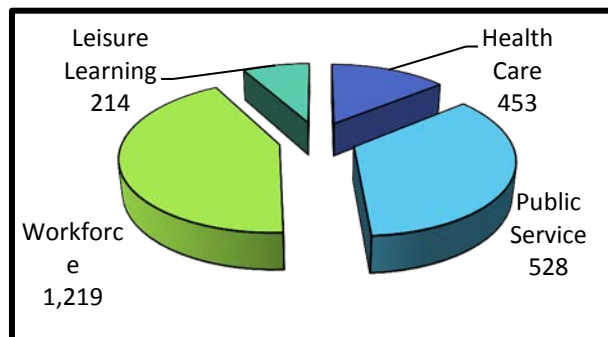

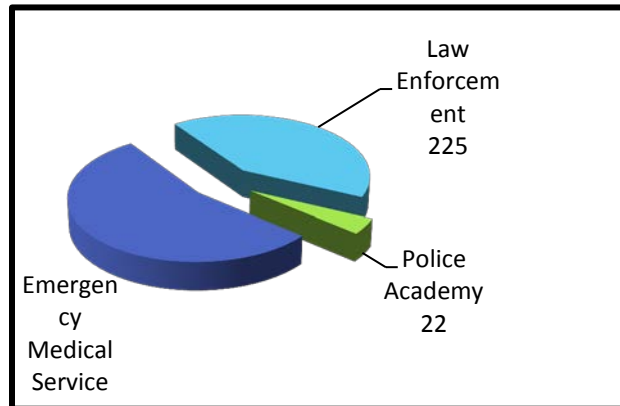

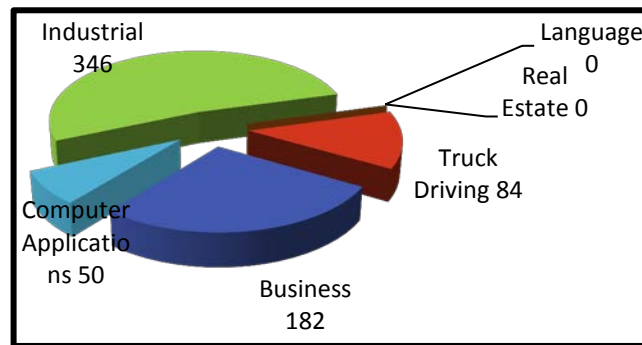
