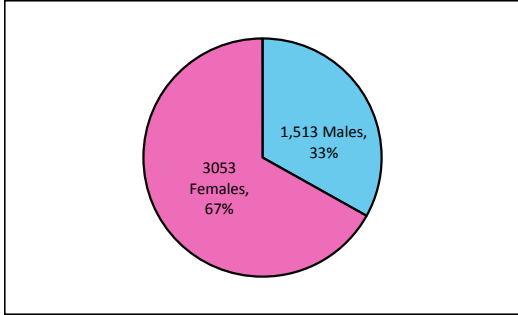

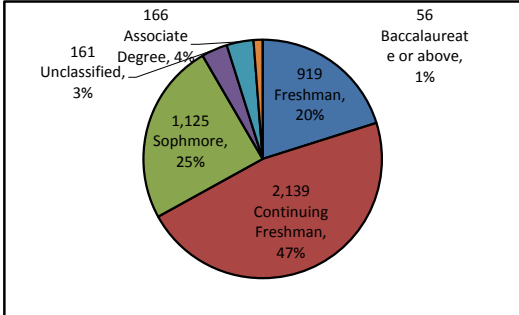

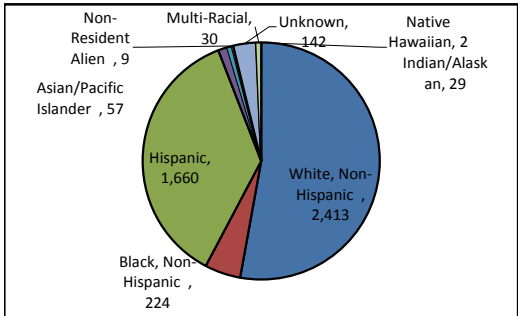
Total Enrollment by Gender



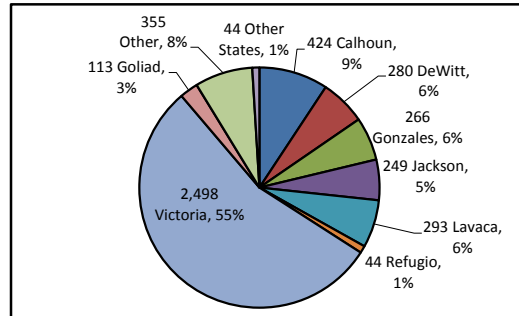
Student Classification



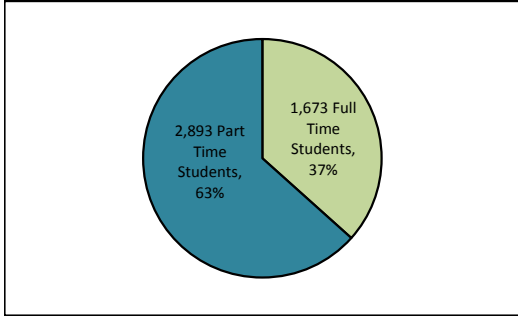
Enrollment by Race



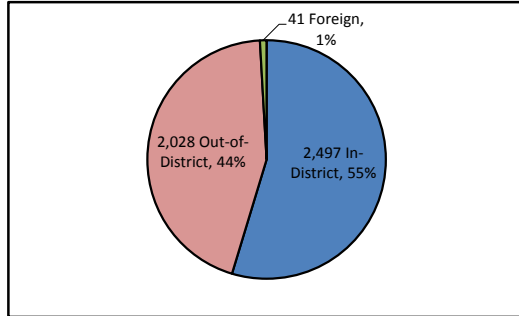
Student Counties of Residence



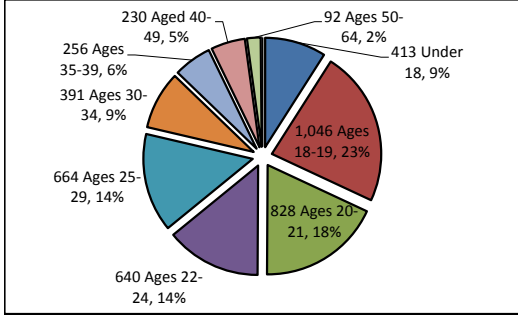

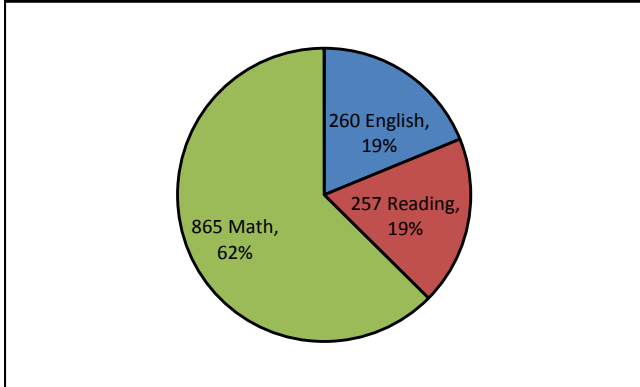

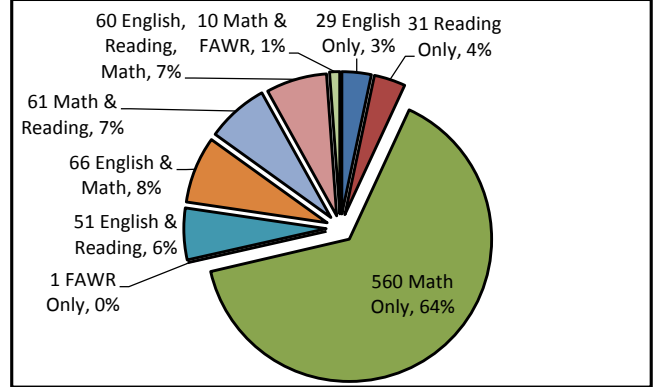

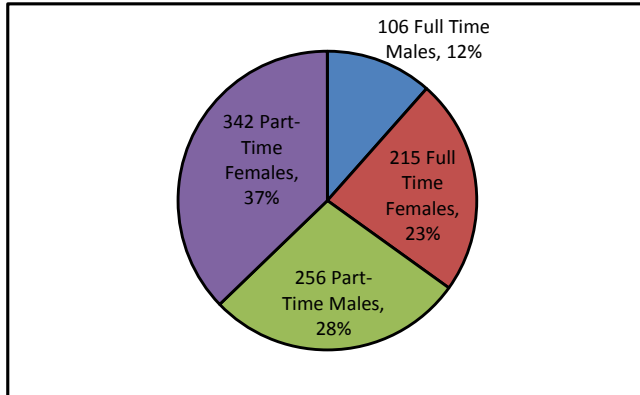


Enrollment by Course Combination

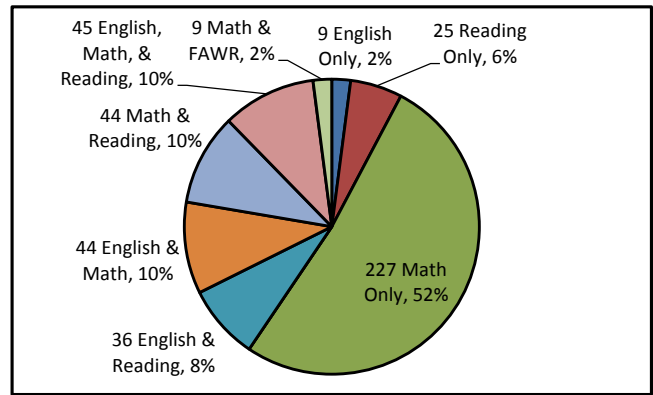

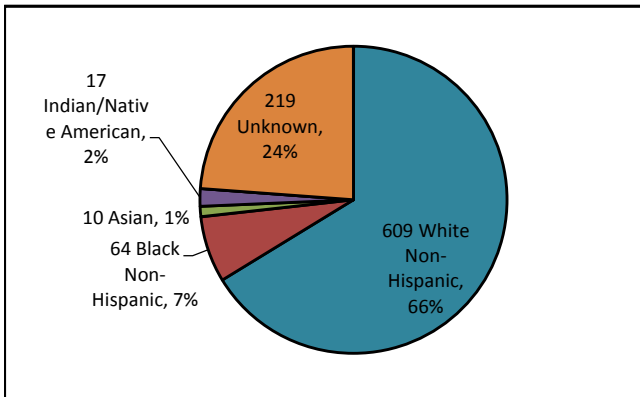
Enrollment Status by Gender



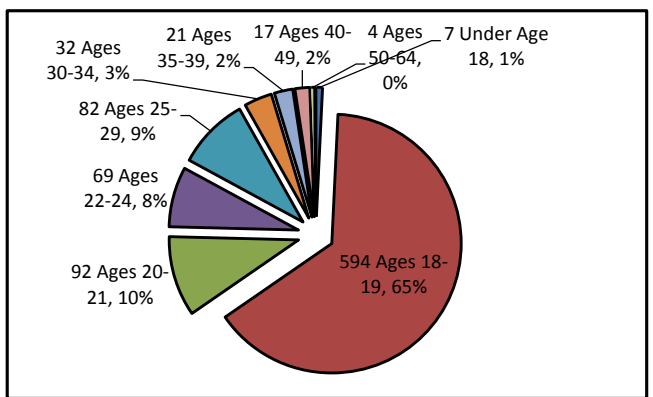
Development Education Combined Enrollment

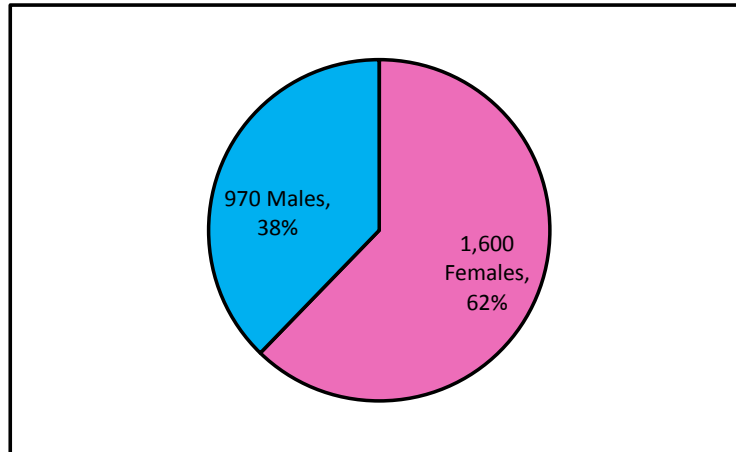

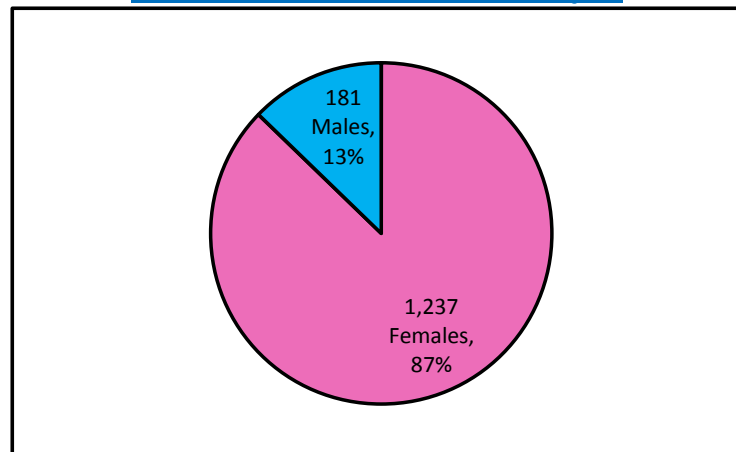

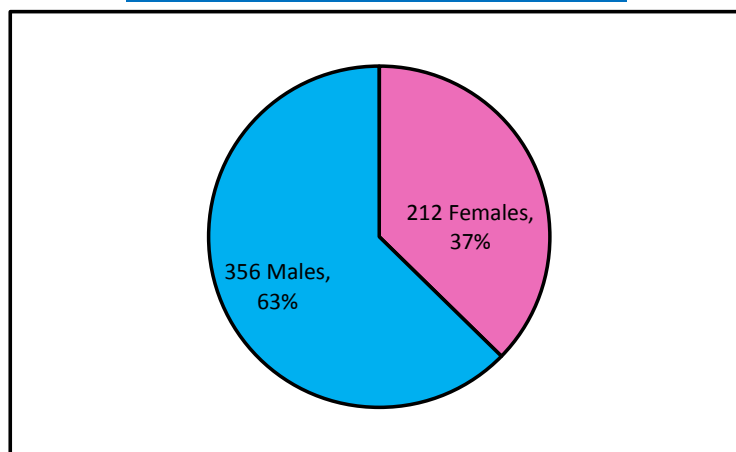
Student Gender in Academic Majors



Student Gender in Allied Health Majors

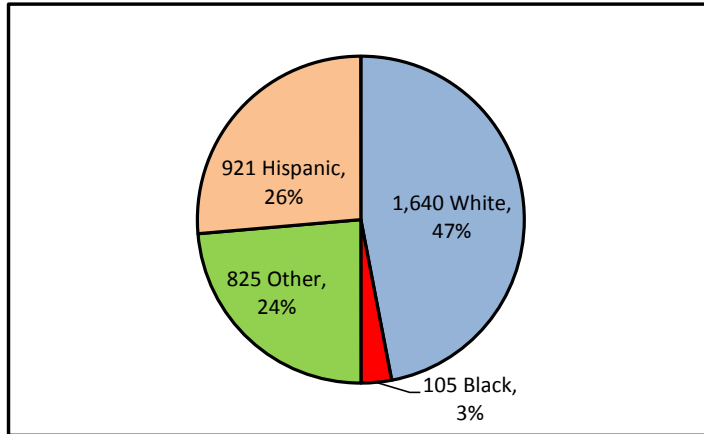


Student Gender in Workforce Programs

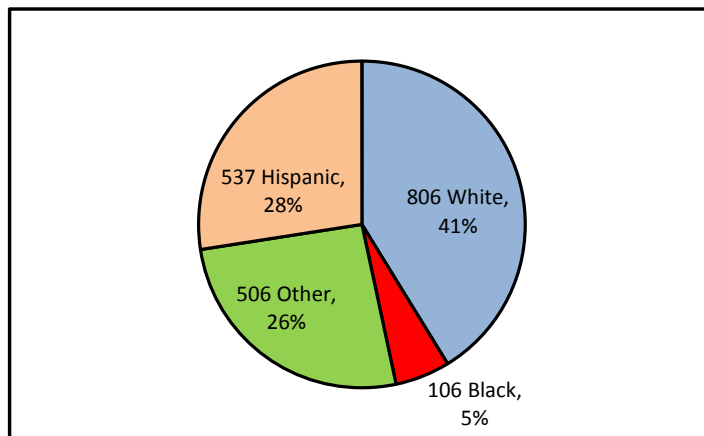

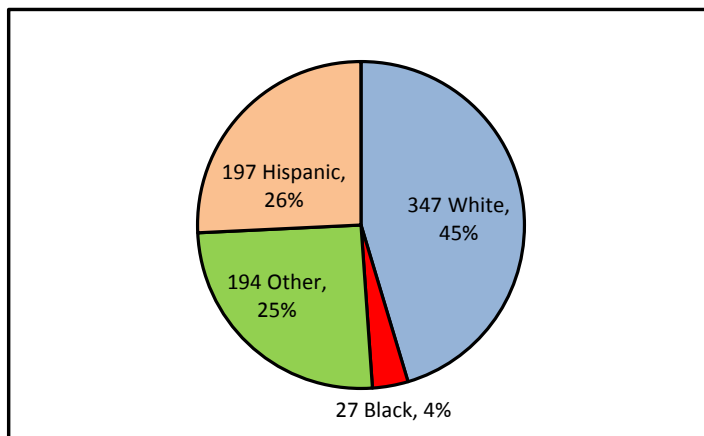
Student Ethnicity Academic Programs

Leisure Learning Students by Concentration

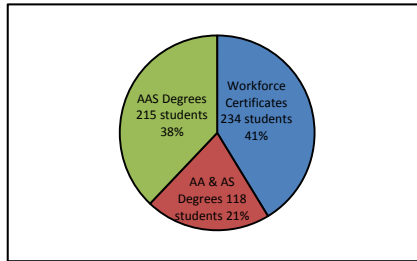

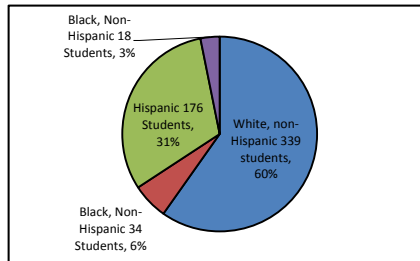

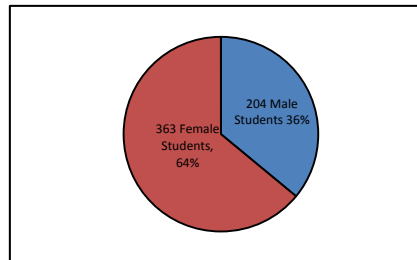

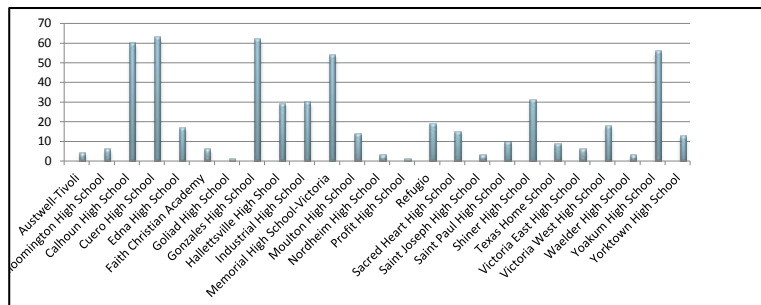
Certificates and Degree Conferred by Ethnicity
