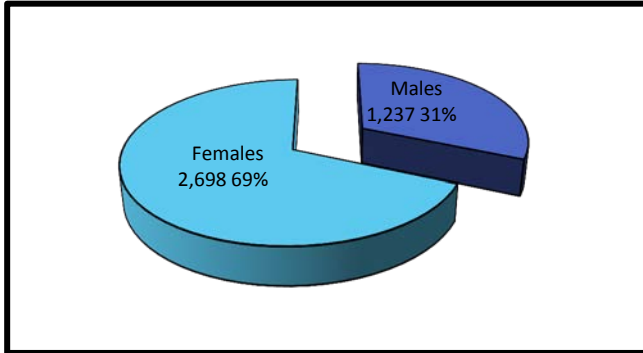

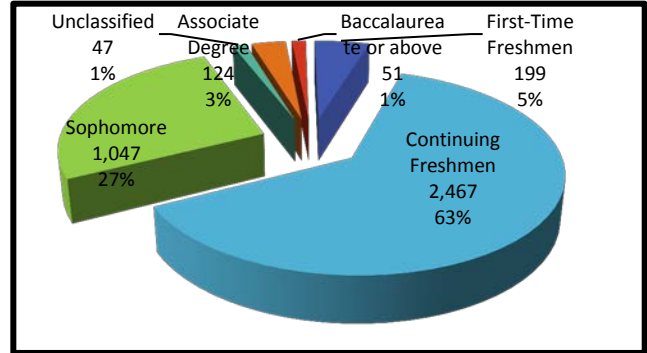

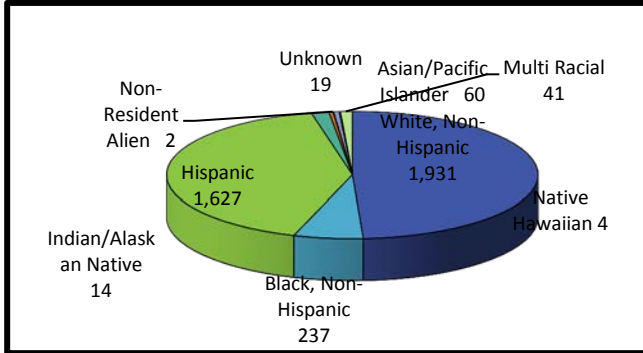
Total Enrollment by Gender



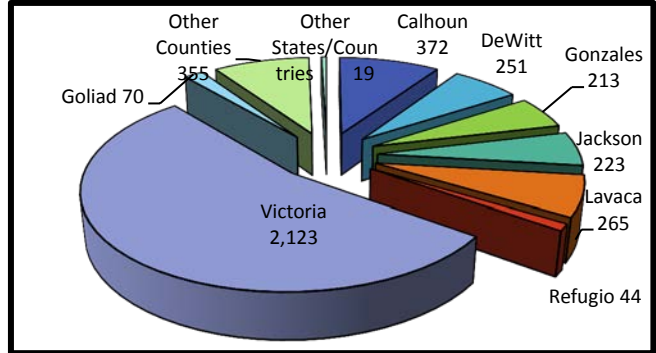
Student Classification



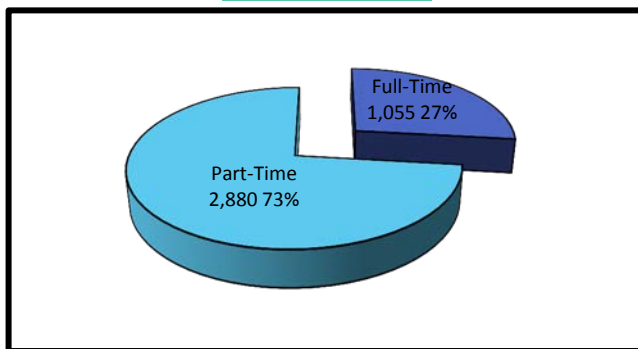
Enrollment by Race



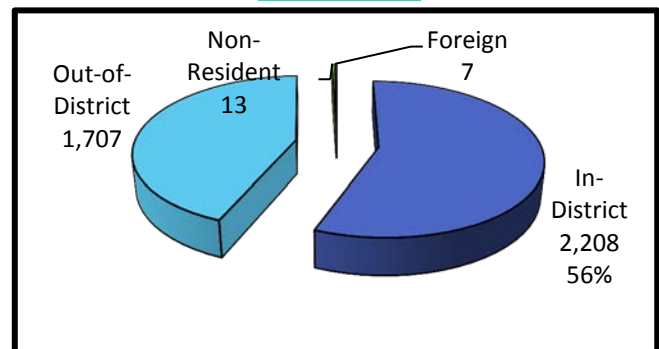
Student Counties of Residence



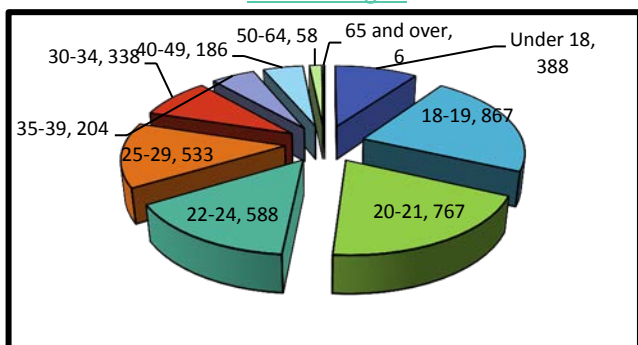

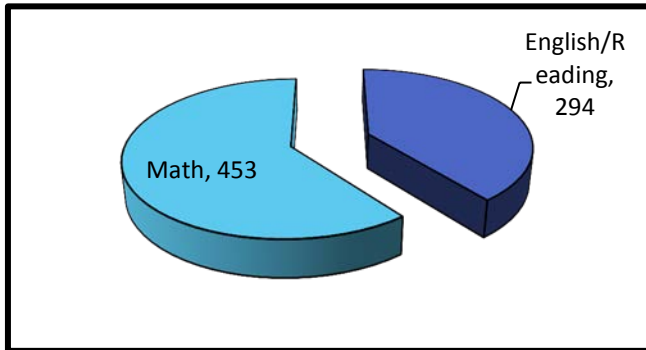

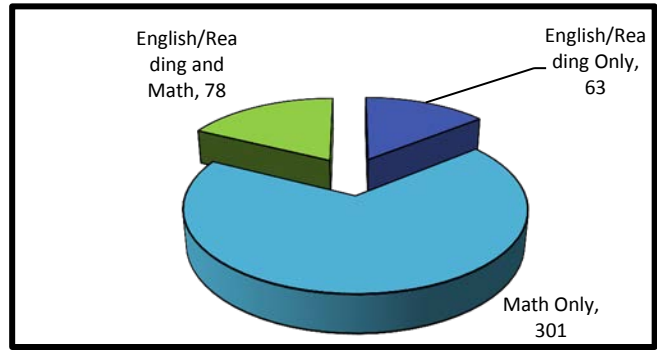

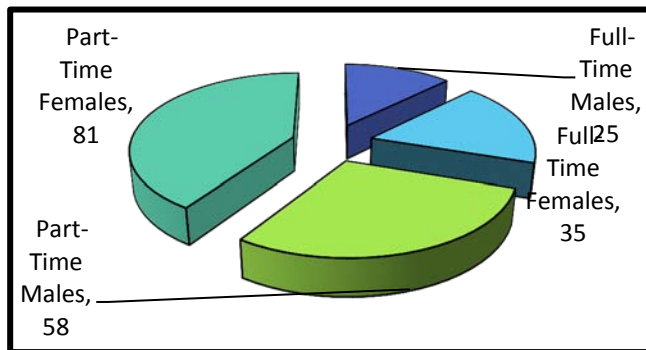

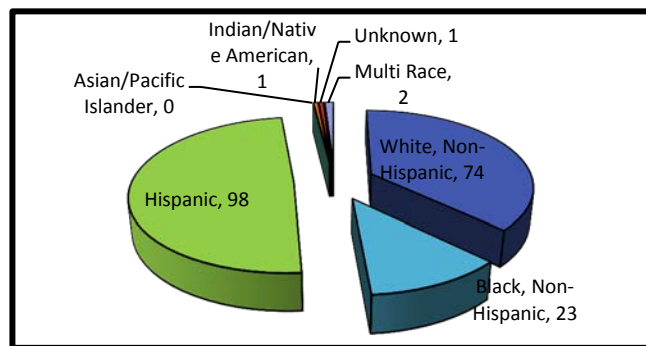
Enrollment Status by Gender



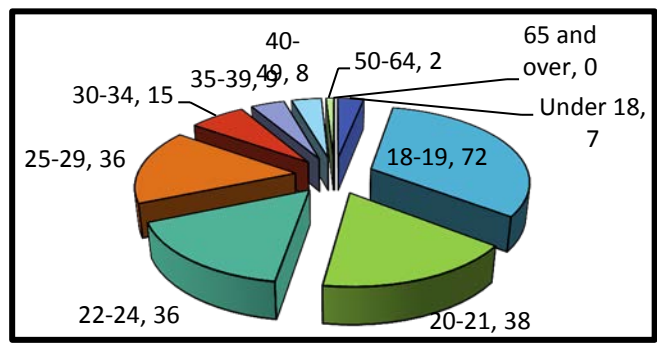
Developmental Education Combined Enrollment



Enrollment by Ethnicity

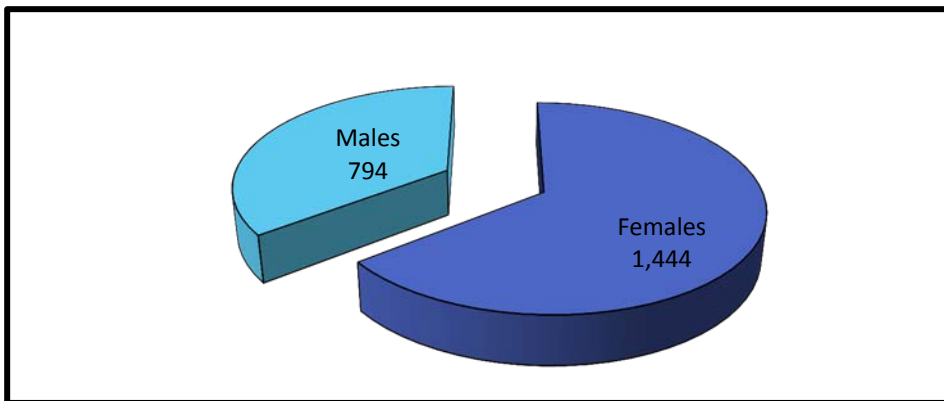

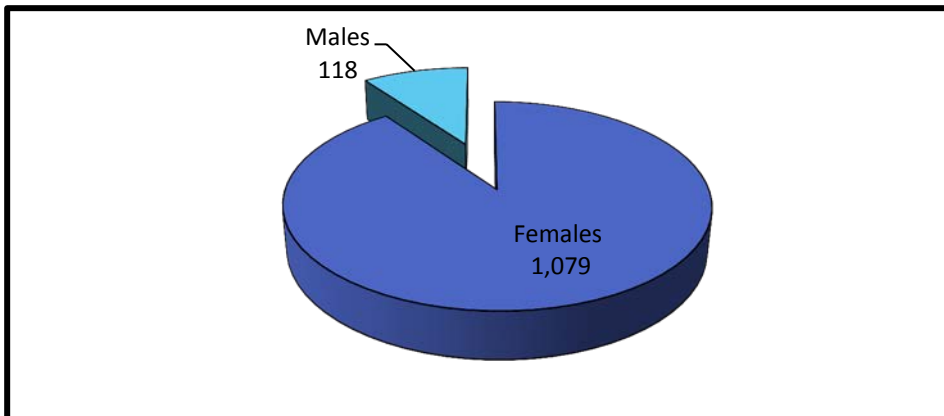

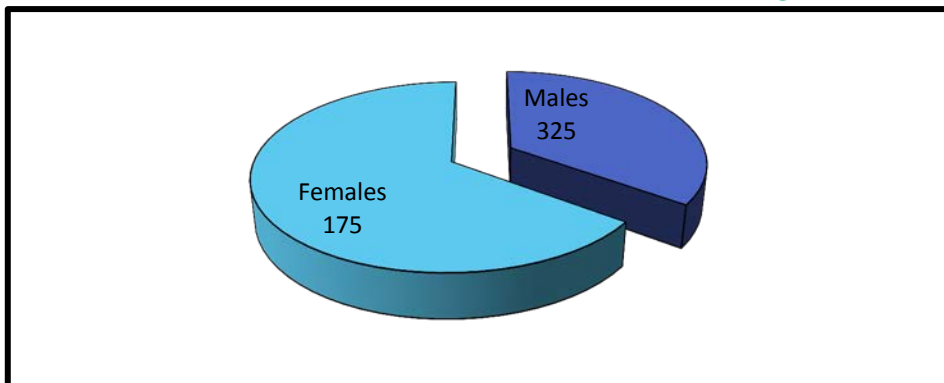
Student Gender in Academic Majors



Student Gender in Allied Health Majors

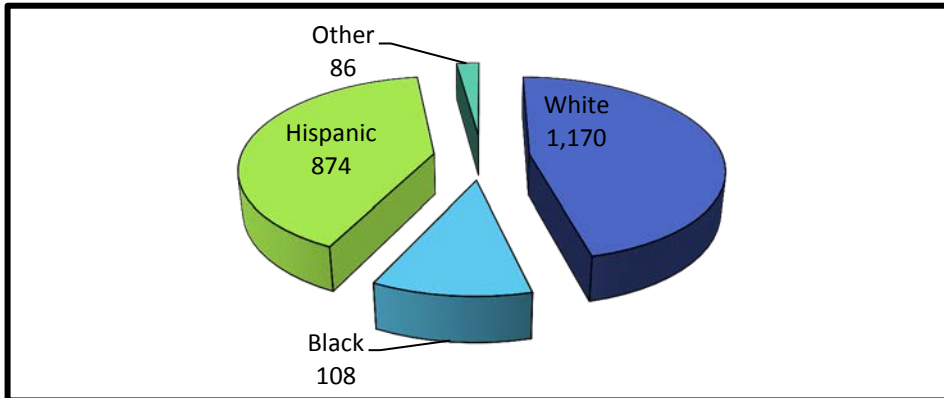


Student Gender in Career and Technical Education Programs

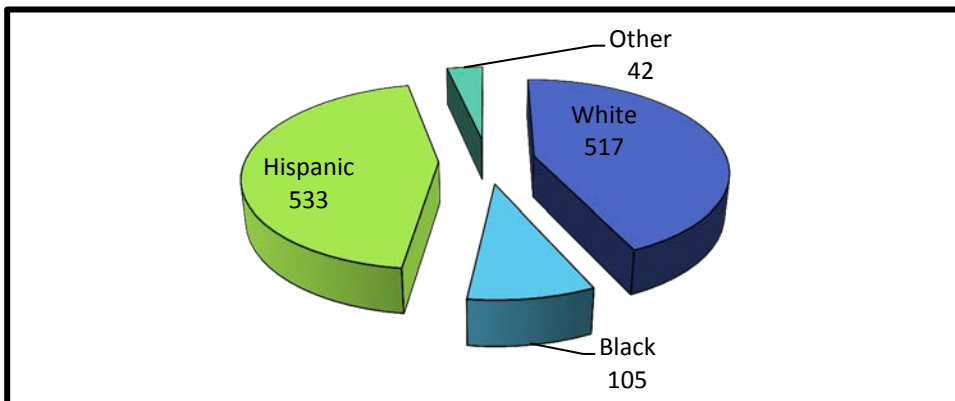

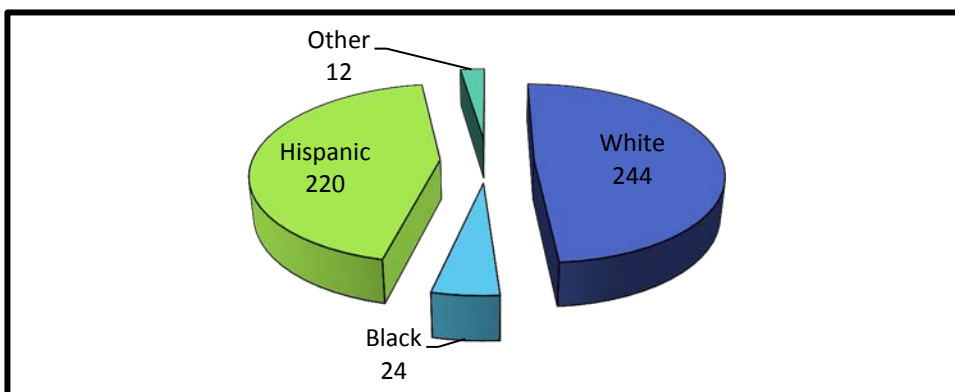
Student Ethnicity in Academic Programs

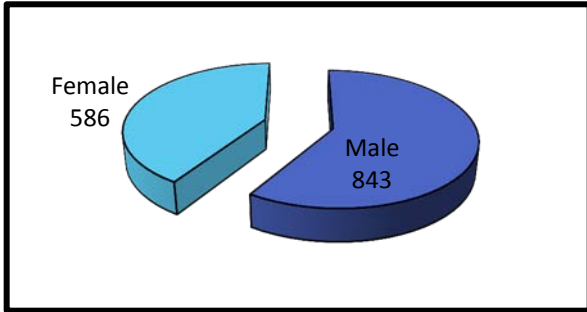

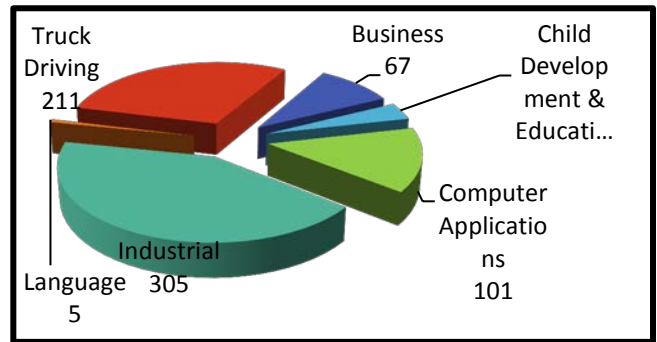
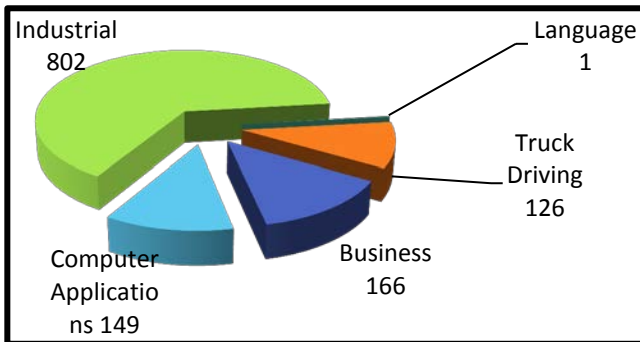
Public Service Students by Type

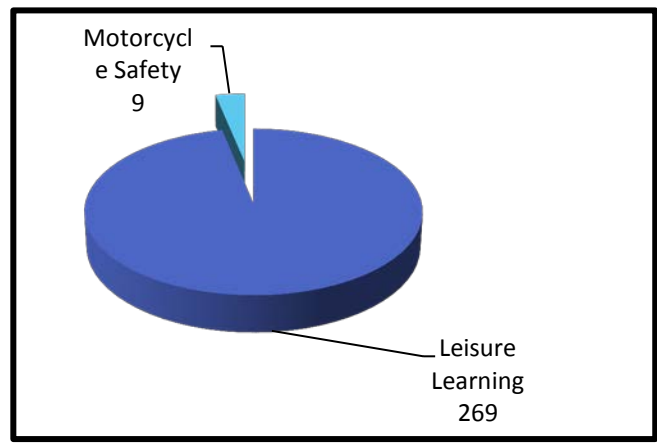
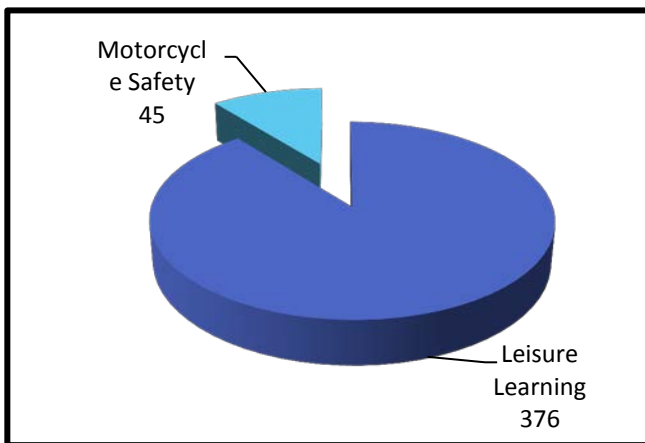

Workforce Students by Type

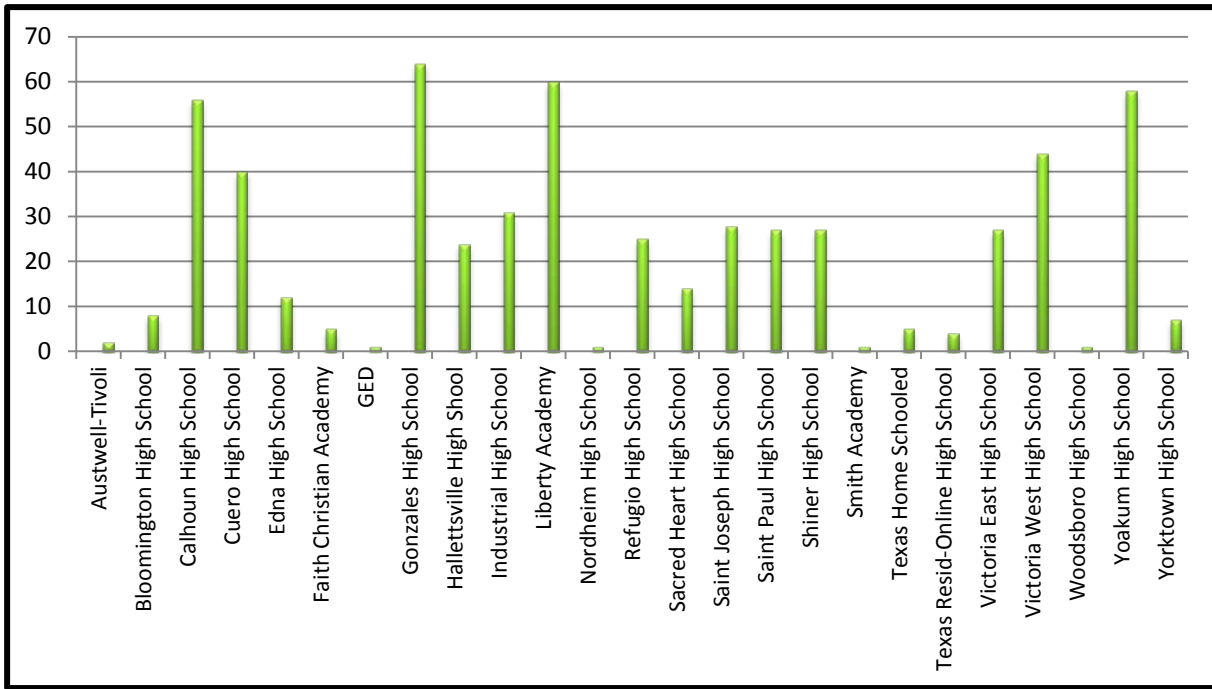


Leisure Learning Students by Type
