Technical Standards

Students will be expected to have the skills and abilities to meet the standards described below:

- Physical demands
 - o Lift at least 25 pounds of weight
 - Frequent or prolonged walking/standing
 - o Reaching, stooping, bending, kneeling or crouching
- Motor skills
 - Perform multiple motor tasks simultaneously
 - Fine and gross motor skills sufficient to handle equipment and provide safe and effective patient care
 - Steady arm and hand movements while manipulating objects or assisting patients.
- Tactile
 - Tactile ability sufficient to assess patient's response to therapy
- Visual
 - Ability sufficient to monitor and assess patient and equipment function and to provide safe and effective respiratory care
 - o Near acuity ability to see clearly at 20 inches or less
 - o Far acuity ability to see clearly at 20 feet or more
 - Field of vision able to see peripherally
 - Depth perception able to judge distance
 - o Color vision able to distinguish and identify different colors
- Hearing
 - o Ability sufficient to hear and understand patients and staff
 - o Hear normal speech
 - Hear without seeing lips
 - Hear faint body sounds
 - o Hear auditory alarms
