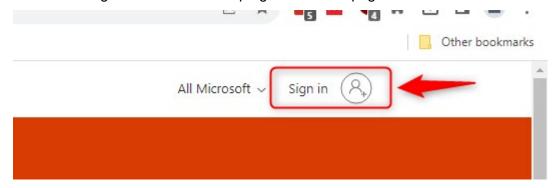


Adding an alternate sign-in option for Office 365

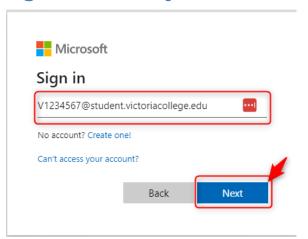
Follow these instructions to add in an alternate sign in option for Microsoft Office 365.

Computer

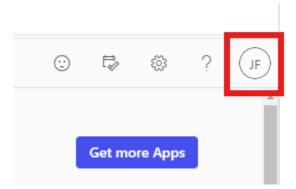
- 1. From a computer open a web browser and navigate to https://www.office.com.
- 2. Select the "Sign in" button at the top right of the webpage.



Sign into Office 365 using Pirate portal username @student.victoriacollege.edu
V#@student.victoriacollege.edu or PM123456student.victoriacollege.edu then Select Next.

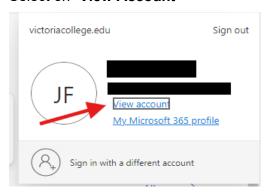


- 4. Type in your Pirate Portal password.
- 5. Select the circle that has your initials in the top-right corner.

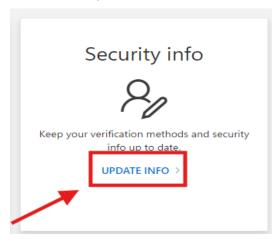




6. Select on "View Account



7. In the Security info section, Select "Update Info"



8. Select on + "Add sign-in method"



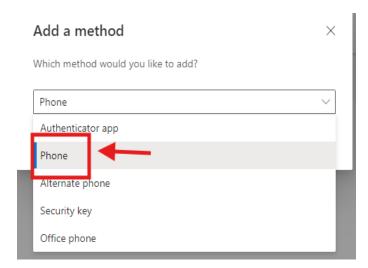


9. Select one of the method options listed.



Example of adding in 2nd MFA Option (Phone)

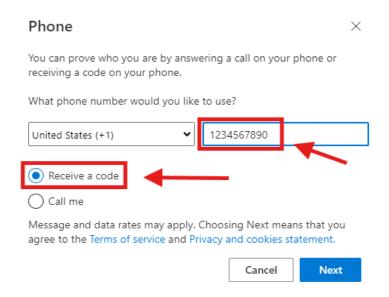
10. In this example, the $\ensuremath{\text{\bf phone}}$ option was selected as the 2^{nd} MFA option.



11. Select Add

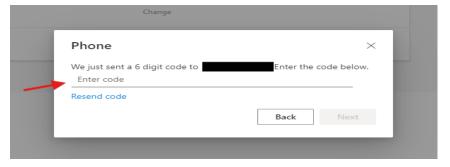


12. Select the "Enter phone number" field, enter the phone number in the field. Then select one of the options available to receive a code by text, or the call me option. Then Select next.



In the example: the **receive a code** option was selected. A text message will be sent to your phone.

13. You will receive a code either by text or phone call, enter the code, then Select next.



14. After Selecting **next**, a message should be displayed on the screen: Verification complete. Your phone has been registered. Select **Done.**
