Electrocardiogram Technician

This 64-hour course will cover fundamentals of cardiovascular anatomy and physiology; Including basic electrocardiography procedures, interpretation of basic dysrhythmias, and appropriate treatment modalities. Students will be able to describe the anatomy and physiology of the cardiovascular system, perform basic electrocardiography procedures, and interpret basic dysrhythmias.

Once a student successfully passes the NHA certification exam they will be a Certified EKG Technician (CET).

Medication Aide for Nurse Aide

A medication aide is a certified nursing assistant (CNA) that has completed additional classroom training to be certified to dispense medications to patients while working under the supervision of a registered nurse. Class is face to face combined with online modules. (130 lecture hours and 10 clinical hours)

A medication aide is permitted by the Texas Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) to administer medications to residents in:

- nursing facilities
- · intermediate care facilities for individuals with an intellectual disability or related conditions
- correctional institutions
- assisted living (personal care) facilities

Medication Aide Update

Intensive training in an identified area(s) to meet continuing education and/or review/update requirements associated with professional licensure or certification. Medication Aides MUST renew their permit annually. This includes taking this 7 hour WCE course and paying the \$15 fee to the Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS). First year permit holders may renew by paying the DADS fee only. Permits that have lapsed for one year or more CANNOT be renewed. The 7 hour continuing education class should be taken at least three months before your permit expires. A medication aide is also a nurse aide and must receive nurse aide continuing in-service documentation. Course is strictly online. This course is no longer offered face-to-face.

Veterinary Assistant

Survey of veterinary medicine, including veterinary-related careers, safety in the veterinary workplace, the human-companion animal bond, animal restraint, client relations, and basic medical terminology. Clinical will cover survey of basic veterinary and nursing care skills. Includes aseptic techniques and operating room procedures, and the roles and responsibilities of the veterinary team in a clinical setting.

Once a student successfully passes the certification exam they will be a Certified Veterinary Assistant (CVA.)
