The course is intended for physicians, nurses, paramedical personnel, respiratory therapists, and other critical/emergency care professionals who have a need to understand the recommended treatments for critical cardiac patients prior to, during, and post arrest. This course includes lecture, discussion, and skills practice following the current American Heart Association guidelines for CPR, cardiac arrest recognition, cardiac compressions, first aide, and use of Automated External Defibrillator. This class is designed for non-Healthcare Providers, including school teachers, athletic trainers, baby sitters, day care centers, volunteer responders, industrial and construction safety personnel, and other lay rescuers. All course materials, including textbook, provided. 8 contact hours.
