

#### **Topics in Psychology: The Silent Twins**

"The Silent Twins," June and Jennifer Gibbons, were identical twins who exhibited the phenomenon of folie à deux, a rare psychiatric disorder where shared delusions exist between close individuals. The twins developed their own secret language and communicated solely with each other. Their behavior included criminal activities, leading to their institutionalization.
