### **Scaffolding Certified Performance Verification -\$250 CBFM CE01**

**Prerequisite: Successful completion of Knowledge Verification for Scaffolding through the Industrial Merit Shop Education Foundation (IMSEF).**

Formerly known as the "Certified Plus" credential, the "Certified" credential establishes that an individual has reached the journey-level minimum competency for knowledge and performance. Successful certification requires you to pass the Knowledge Verified and Performance Verification assessments which results in you receiving wallet cards, a transcript, and a certificate.

Scaffolding Certified Plus Performance Verifications will be scheduled on an as needed basis. Minimum class size is 2 participants. Please contact (361) 582-2528 for scheduling options.

This course is offered at the VC Emerging Technology Complex, Industrial Training Center, Room 121. Course length will depend on experience level, with a maximum of 7 hours allowable.
